Dear Professor Abbate,

At their July 2020 meeting, the directors of the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) streamlined the interim reporting process. Effective January 1, 2021, the Five-Year IPR submissions will now only be required for programs whose Two-Year or Three-Year IPR did not satisfy deficiencies stated in the previous VTR.

As a follow up to our announcement of July 30, 2020 regarding these changes to the interim reporting process, we are providing direct communication with programs that may be impacted.

A review of your program's Two-Year IPR indicated that an update on anticipated leadership changes within the College and the School of Architecture must be provided; therefore, your program is still required to submit a Five-Year IPR in 2022.

The new reporting process, for both Three-Year and Five-Year IPRs, will be modeled after the [2020 Conditions and Procedures](#) 'Plan to Correct' and will facilitate a smoother transition to the new set of *Conditions* and *Procedures*.
