## Combined B.A./M.A. with Major in History

The B.A./M.A. with major in History combined degree program enables outstanding students to graduate with both a Bachelor of Arts in History (B.A.) and a Master of Arts in History (M.A.) in as little as five years. The program is 150 credits (B.A./M.A. with thesis option) or 156 credits (B.A./M.A. without thesis option). Students complete 120 credits for the undergraduate degree and 30 credits (thesis option) or 36 credits (non-

the B.A. degree, including HIS 3150: Historical Methods, and HIS 4935: Senior Seminar.

- 2. Applicants must have a minimum 3.25 GPA for the last 60 undergraduate credits attempted.
