- i Submit an application form, ESE program sheet, and a le 4er of recommendation from an FAU ESE faculty member.

In addition to completing the ESE program of studies, students who participate in HOOT, the ESE Honors in the Major will:

- (1) Participate in Honors Enrichmentptions each semester;
- (2) Complete the Honors Seminar in ESEn senior year; and,
- (3) Complete an Honors Compacturing student teaching.
