Quarantine is not required. Continue to report to assigned work or classes unless you develop symptoms. Test 5 days from the day of exposure. Wear a mask around others for 10 days.	Do not come to work or class and contact your supervisor or faculty member if you will be absent from assigned work or classes. Employees must use sick time unless remote work is authorized. If you have not been tested, test immediately. If you are negative, communicate with your supervisor or faculty member regarding returning to work/class as with any other illness. If you are positive, isolate at home for 5 days. If after 5 days you are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication and your symptoms are improving, or you never had symptoms, you may end isolation after day 5. Wear a mask around others for an additional 5 days.
