Although the overall Greek GPA increased this semester by .17 points and individual Greeks did very well. The number of Greeks with 4.0 increased, and the number of Greeks with a 3.0 GPA continues to increase. Sororities this semester all had increases in chapter GPAs for the most part. Some chapters weren't listed because they did not have enough members on their roster or enough enrolled this semester to be fairly compared to other Greek chapters.

This semester's grade report also lists each member of your organization who is on probation, freshman warning, academic suspension and academic dismissal. If your organization takes into account grades from other institutions during the semester it's your responsibility to bring those transcripts to the Greek Life office.
