The proposed program change is a new program in the College of Business Administration, Department of Management, titled "Bachelor of Science in Business Administration with a Concentration in Supply Chain Management." The program is designed to provide students with a strong foundation in business administration and a specialized focus on supply chain management. The program will be offered as a four-year degree program with a total of 120 credit hours required for graduation. The program is expected to begin in the fall semester of 2013.
