



The research shows that students can and do increase their leadership skills during the college years (Pascarella & Terenzini, 2005) and that “increases in leadership development in turn

enhance the self-efficacy, civic engagement, character development, academic performance, and personal development of students” (Dugan & Komives, 2007).

According to the Council for the Advancement of Standards in Higher Education, “Regardless of
