I. Background

- Journal articles should not be published without the appropriate approval. Most peer reviewed journals require evidence of IRB, IACUC, and/or IBC approval when considering articles for publication.
- The University does not support research conducted without the appropriate compliance committee approval. Data secured before such approval may be disapproved for use by the IRB, IACUC, and/or IBC.
- The University has the authority to suspend all research activities for a specified time frame as a disciplinary measure.
