



Field Practicum Education

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AGENCY FIELD PRACTICUM SITE REQUIREMENTS

Allow for minimum of one hour weekly supervision of student by a staff member who is qualified as an FAU field educator.

Provide micro (individual), mezzo (group/families) and macro (community) learning experiences.

Allow BSW or MSW staff to attend 12-hour Field Practicum Educator training if not already completed.

Able to support social work education with resources, office space, supplies, and technical support.

Provide appropriate social work activities at the micro, mezzo and macro levels.

Adhere to the NASW Code of Ethics.

Serve a diverse client population representative of South Florida.

Reimburse students for mileage incurred on agency business.

Maintain 200 Tf8ode

Site visits by FAU social work faculty will occur at least once during the internship, or more if needed. The student, faculty representative and field educator will review the student's progress and needs.

BSW

BSW students complete a block field placement in their final semester of school. They report to the agency between 27 and 34 hours per week for a total of 400 hours minimum. Placements can be in any semester.

BSW field placements allow students to apply their generalist social work practice skills learned in era14stt .9(l)-12.2 cigeaetoætira14si(e)8.7 (r)22.5 (e)8.6 (a)

practice skills with individuals, families, groups and communities.
